16.01.2023 - 20.01.2023	<p>Issuing the half-yearly report cards at the primary schools</p> <p>Issuing of enrolment forms for the municipal schools You will receive one enrolment form from your child's primary school. Please fill this in and take it with you to the enrolment at a municipal secondary school. If you wish to enrol your child at a private school, you will receive information on the enrolment procedure from the respective private school.</p> <p>Tips for choosing a secondary school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be aware of the transition recommendation of the primary school! • Does the (pedagogical) concept of the school meet the needs of your child? • In your opinion, which school supports your child best? • What impressions did you / your child gain at the open day? • How do you get to school? Is the school easy and safe to reach for your child? • Is the school a full-day or half-day school? (Supervision in the afternoon hours available?) • Is the school a municipal or private school? • If your child would like to take part in native language classes (HSU = herkunftssprachlicher Unterricht), please inform yourself about the possibilities of the respective secondary school.
06.02.2023 - 03.03.2023	<p>Enrolment period at the municipal secondary schools</p> <p>Enrolment for the fifth grade of the school term 2023/24 should take place if possible on 08.02.2023 / 09.02.2023 in each case from 09.00 - 12.00 am and 04:00 – 07:00 pm on 10.02.2023 / 13.02.2023 / 14.02.2023 in each case from 09.00 - 12.00 am.</p> <p>To comply with the current hygiene and distance rules, enrolments should be made after making an appointment, if possible.</p> <p>The enrolment dates for the private secondary schools are based on the municipal schools. Please consult the respective private school for the specific enrolment dates.</p>

	<p>Enrolment at the secondary school</p> <p>Enrolment takes place in the school office / secretary's office of the respective secondary school.</p> <p>What do I need to bring with me to the enrolment?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The filled in enrolment form (you will receive the enrolment form from your primary school). ✓ Your child's last half-year school report (grade 4) from primary school, including the transition recommendation for the type of school. ✓ The birth certificate of your child who is to be registered at the secondary school. ✓ If available: Proof of your child's swimming ability (e.g. proof of the swimming badge "Seepferdchen") ✓ The vaccination book / vaccination certificate as proof of measles protection. ✓ If your child would like to take part in native language classes (HSU = herkunftssprachlicher Unterricht), the registration on the HSU should take place with the enrolment.

	<p>Pupils travel expenses / SchülerTicket Westfalen</p> <p>As of 01.02.2023 (2nd school term), the <i>SchülerCard</i> / <i>Schulwegticket</i> for pupils of municipal schools will be replaced by the SchülerTicket Westfalen. The new <i>SchülerTicket Westfalen</i> can <u>only be applied for via the school</u> with a fully completed order form.</p> <p>It is valid as a monthly ticket for <u>all</u> local public transport in Westphalia, <u>unlimited, around the clock</u> and for one school year. Eligible pupils receive the <i>SchülerTicket Westfalen</i> on payment of a monthly contribution of €12 (€6 for one sibling and €0 for additional siblings).</p> <p>Holders of a currently valid Bielefeld Pass / SGB-II-Bescheide / SGB-XII-Bescheide [notice letter for unemployment benefits according to the Social Security Code] or a notice letter for asylum seekers with entitlement to school transport costs receive the <i>SchülerTicket Westfalen</i> free of charge. (Unfortunately, the education card is not sufficient as proof).</p> <p>For all those who have no entitlement to school travel costs and therefore no entitlement to a subsidy, the <i>SchülerTicket Westfalen</i> costs between €30 - €36 per month as a self-payer (the monthly price is currently (as of 27.10.2022) not yet</p>		

	<p>fixed). The fully completed order form/application must be submitted to the transport provider after confirmation by the school.</p> <p>TIP: Further information can also be found in the leaflet 'Schülerfahrkosten' (available in the school office of the schools or in the local education authority) or on the internet at www.bielefeld.de (keywords: Bildung / Rund ums Thema Schule / Schülerfahrkosten) as from December 2022.</p>
